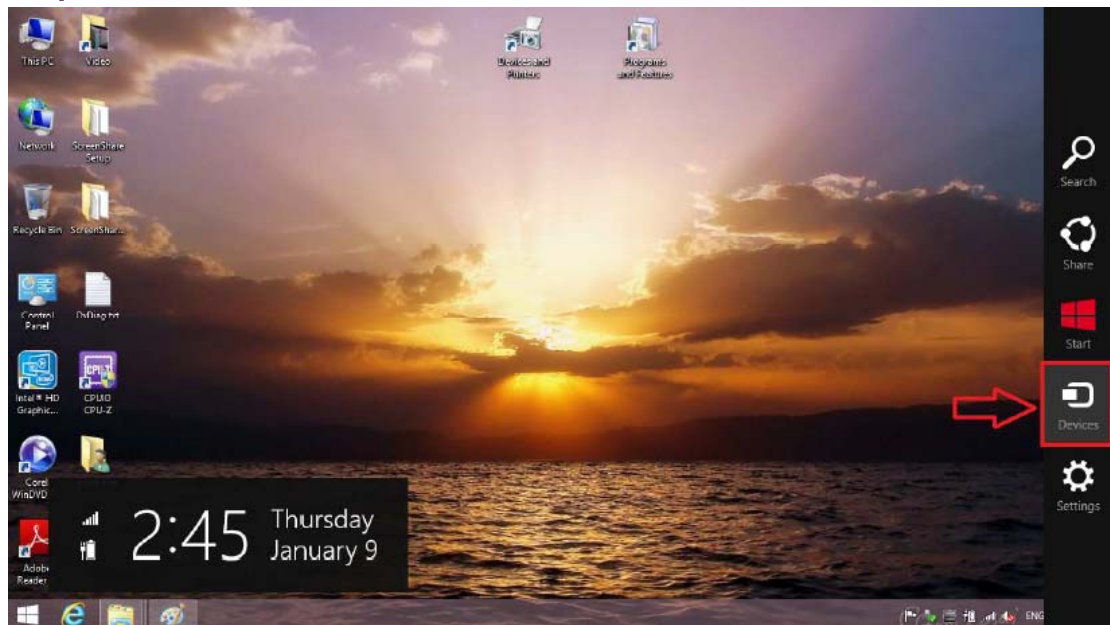
Q:How to connect the WTV-3000 in Windows 8.1?

System requirements

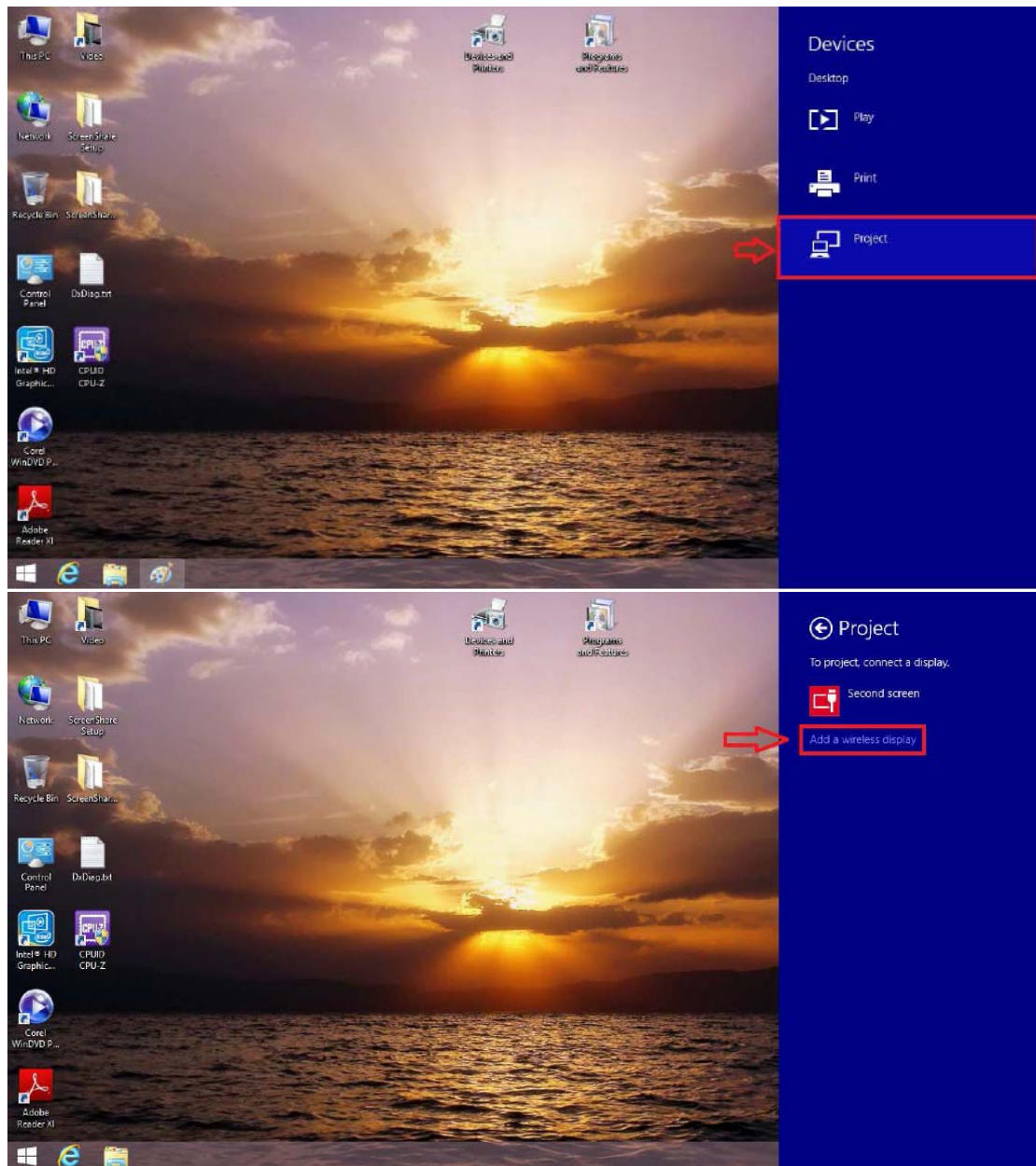
1. Graphics driver can be updated to WDDM 1.3.
2. Network adapter can be updated to NDIS 6.3.
3. Windows 8.1 build number is up to 9600.

Please refer to the following steps to connect WTV-3000 in Windows 8.1:

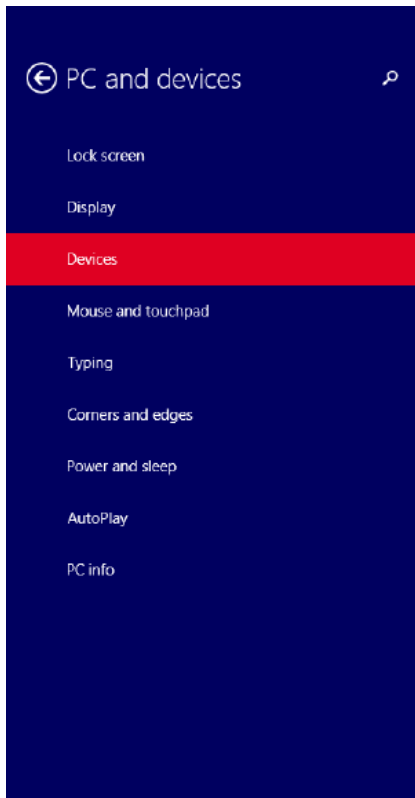
Step 1. Go to "Toolbar" → "Device"



Step 2. Go to "Project" → "Add a wireless display".

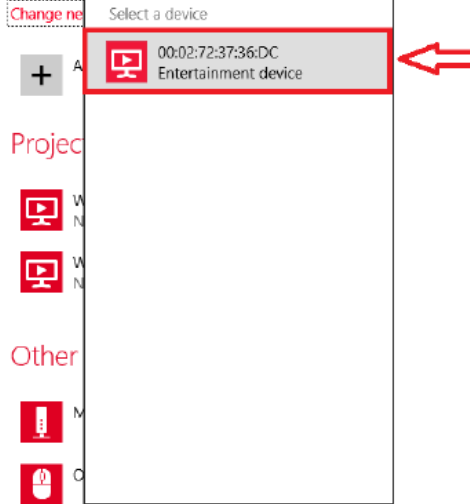


Step 3. Click your “Device” or “MAC address”



Add devices

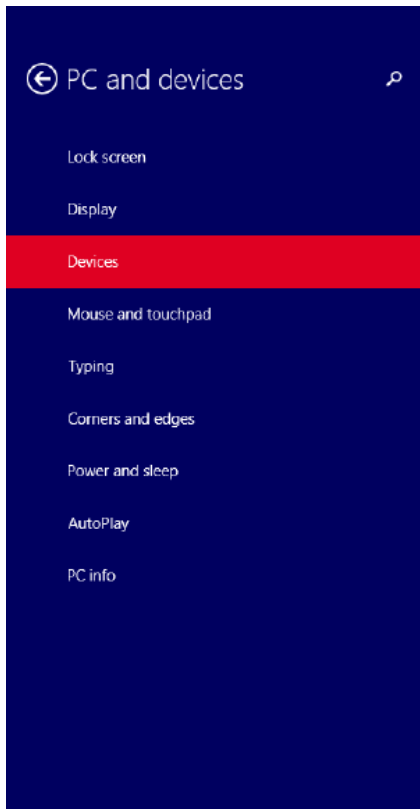
Add devices such as TVs or printers. If your device isn't found, you might need to change your network settings.

To help prevent extra charges, keep this off so device software (drivers, info, and apps) for new devices won't download while you're on metered Internet connections.

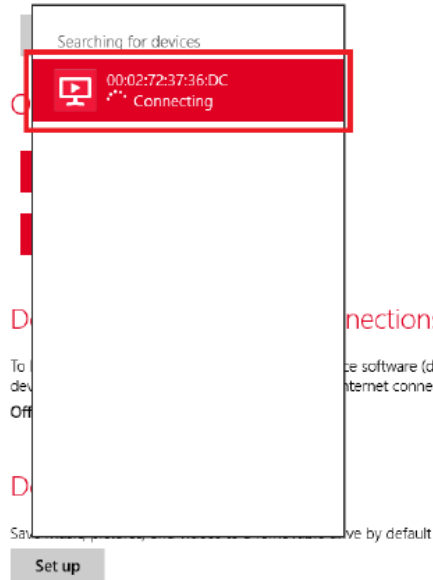
